Karen Moore Photography Studios will be at Lincoln School on September 22 and 23 to take school pictures (juniors) and senior portraits. Junior pictures will be taken on Wednesday until 4:00 p.m. Seniors will be able to sit for portraits on Thursday from 8:00 a.m. until approximately 5:30 p.m.

Enclosed for junior parents is a payment envelope, with a price list. Your student will have to present the envelope, with payment enclosed, to the photographer on picture day if you are ordering a packet. *No one is obligated to purchase a packet*, but every junior will sit for a picture so we have one for the OSSM yearbook.

Every senior must sit for a senior portrait on Thursday, again, so we have a picture of every student for the yearbook. Senior pictures for the yearbook will be taken in graduation robes, which we will provide. Senior men should wear a white or blue dress shirt and a tie. Collars for the robes will be provided for the young women. Your senior can also sit for a picture in street clothes at no cost if you think you would like to order pictures for your personal use.

Seniors will have the opportunity to purchase finished senior portraits – you will receive a price list with your proofs. Moore Studios' finished portraits are retouched, textured, and sprayed with a lacquer to preserve them.
