



## LEARNING OPTIONS

Two options are being given to families of OSSM students: Return to Campus or Remote Learning. OSSM administrators feel it is important to be extremely transparent on both options.

Returning to campus will guarantee students more face time with professors and social interactions with their peers. However, they will be required to strictly adhere to all policies in this document. Remote learning will continue similar to the fall semester. However, students will be required to adhere to their class schedule and virtually attend classes as if on campus.

#### RETURN TO CAMPUS

- Decision due by Thursday, December 17 to move-in items the weekend of December 18. Students may move-in items such as bookcases, bedding, chairs to ease the process of January move-in.
- Decision due by Monday, December 21 to move-in only in January

#### REMOTE LEARNING

- Decision due by Monday, December 21
- Option to opt-in at end of first grading period

At the end of the first grading period, OSSM Administration will reevaluate the COVID-19 situation using the COVID-19 State Department of Education map. If Oklahoma county is **RED** or **ORANGE 2** OSSM will give families the two above options for the second grading period. If Oklahoma county is **ORANGE 1, yellow or green**, all students will be required to return to campus. Learning option decisions can only be made at the conclusion of each grading period.
