Computer Science Professor

The Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics (OSSM), located in Oklahoma City, is a state-funded, residential high school delivering college-level instruction to juniors and seniors who choose to focus their academics in STEM topics. More information about OSSM can be found at www.ossm.edu.

The Computer Science Professor position is a full-time, salaried, 10-month faculty position with an anticipated start date at the end of July 2021 or the beginning of August 2021. This position will have the opportunity to develop new courses to supplement existing curriculum. The option to teach remotely is not available.

Summary of Job Functions:

- Plan, evaluate, and revise curriculum, course content, and methods of instruction;
- Instruct live, in-person, college-level Computer Science courses on a rotating basis, including but not limited to: Introduction to Computer Science, Object-Oriented Programming with Java, Data Structures, and Computer Networking;
- Prepare course materials, such as syllabi, homework assignments, and supplemental instructional materials;
- Evaluate and grade students' assignments and exams in a timely manner;
- Maintain student records, grades, and other required records;
- Be available to students or their parents outside of regularly scheduled classes for questions or other types of assistance needed on coursework;
- Keep current on developments in the Computer Science field;
- Occasional evening or weekend hours may be required.

Minimum Qualifications

- Strong academic credentials with an advanced degree in computer science or a related field;
- Previous teaching experience in college-level courses as instructor of record;
- Excellent interpersonal skills as exemplified by a record of working well with faculty, staff, and students.

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience with mathematics and science education in a residential school environment.

Salary

Commensurate with credentials.

Benefits

OSSM employees are state employees and therefore eligible for state benefits including a monthly allowance for medical, dental, vision, and other benefits. State employees accrue generous annual and sick leave, and are eligible for a retirement plan.
