Eligible students for these awards have GPA of 3.5 or higher and have excelled on the PSAT/NMSQT or PSAT 10 or earned a score of 3 or higher on two or more AP Exams. Additional qualifications include an African American Black, Hispanic American or Latinx, or Indigenous ethnicity, and/ or attend school in a rural area.
